New York Times Best-Selling Author Adriana Trigiani at 2013 ALL HENRICO READS

The Henrico County Public Library, in partnership with Henrico County Public Schools and the Friends of Henrico County Public Library will host Adriana Trigiani, Virginia native and author of *The Shoemaker's Wife*, on Wednesday, April 24, 2013, from 7:00 to 8:30 p.m. at Glen Allen High School, 10700 Staples Mill Road, Glen Allen, 23060. Books will be available for sale, and the author will autograph books following the program. Those who attend can enter to win gift certificates to local restaurants and shopping courtesy of the Friends of the Library.

The featured title *The Shoemaker's Wife* spans many decades and begins in the Northern Alps in 1905 and follows the lives of its characters to New York City's Metropolitan Opera House and then to Minnesota. The novel's real-life back story is as arresting as the one Trigiani creates. It's inspired by the love between the author's grandparents, who grew up in the Northern Alps of Italy but did not meet until they emigrated to the United States.
