The Henrico County Public Library, in partnership with Henrico County Public Schools and the Friends of Henrico County Public Library, is proud to host the nationally acclaimed author, David Baldacci, on Tuesday, April 5, from 7:00 to 8:30 p.m. at Glen Allen High School, 10700 Staples Mill Road, Glen Allen, 23060, as part of Henrico's 400th Anniversary Celebration and the community's ALL HENRICO READS. His novel, *Wish You Well*, as the featured title, will be available for sale, as well as some of his other novels. He will autograph books following the program.

David Baldacci, a graduate of Henrico High School, received his Bachelor of Arts in political science from Virginia Commonwealth University and his law degree from the University of Virginia. He practiced law for nine years in Washington, D.C. while he continued to write short stories and screenplays. But it was his first novel and presidential thriller, *Absolute Power*, that won him a place on the New York Times Bestseller List in 1976 and a major motion picture the following year.

Baldacci has authored seven original screenplays, and his works have been published in magazines, newspapers, and journals throughout the world. All of his books have become national and international bestsellers.

David Baldacci serves as a national ambassador for the National Multiple Sclerosis Society and has founded the Wish You Well Foundation for literacy. This event is free and open to the public.
