HENRICO COUNTY PUBLIC LIBRARY WINS VIRGINIA BREAST CANCER FOUNDATION LIBRARY GRANT AWARD

**HCPL is the recipient of funding, materials, and informative programming from VBCF to educate
Henricoans about Breast Cancer.**

Henrico County Public Library is pleased to announce that the library system is a recipient of the Virginia Breast Cancer Foundation's (VBCF) Library Grant Award this year. The grant is given to select libraries in Virginia who apply and is intended to further the VBCF mission to educate the public about breast health and breast cancer.

The VBCF Library Grant Award has financed the purchase of seven high-quality titles on breast cancer and women's health to be added to our collection. These titles will be placed on display at Sandston Library and, as with other HCPL books, people anywhere in the county may place them on hold. The grant also supplies large quantities of brochures in English and Spanish about the VBCF, breast cancer health, and getting access to treatment, which are available at all HCPL locations. Representatives of VBCF will be providing expert programming in Eastern and Western Henrico in the next

Breast cancer is the most common cancer affecting women worldwide, and we believe providing access to these resources is vital to the well-being of our community.
